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## Pre-Procedures:

### Eyebrows

Avoid tweezing, waxing, electrolysis and tinting of the eyebrows for two weeks prior to the procedure, this will ensure the artist to work according to the natural eyebrows and will provide the flexibility to create symmetry.

Please take note that your foundation / concealer will be removed to determine your true undertones. It is vital for us when it comes to choosing the correct colour, Natural Pigmento® offer us a variety of colours to choose from for everyone.

We offer hair strokes (known as microblading), hair strokes with shading (hybrid eyebrows) and fully shaded brows.

Meant to Last artist will discuss the best options for you depending on your skin type, lifestyle, desired results and desired maintenance. Rest assured, we use the best tools and the best pigments in the industry (Imported from the USA & Brazil).

### Eyeliner

Do not wear contact lenses during or immediately after your eyeliner procedure. If one suffers from severe dry eyes, please wear glasses 2 days prior to appointment and ensure continues application of a glycerine-based eye drop.

Remember to bring your glasses. You may resume wearing your contact lenses as soon as your eyes return to their pre-treated condition.

The use of eye lash enhancers must be discontinued at least 3 months prior to your eyeliner procedure. Eye lash enhancer produces an inflammatory reaction in the skin, which causes excessive pain and bleeding, and will cause your eyeliner will not take properly.

Do not use other growth stimulants such as RapidLash®, RevitaLash® or MD Lash® for at least one week prior to or one week after your eyeliner procedure.

Lash extensions must be removed completely before your eyeliner procedure. If you have lash extensions, we will not be able to do your eyeliner. Lash extensions pose a danger to your eyes during the semi-permanent makeup procedure.

## Lips

If you have any history of cold sores, fever blisters, or herpes simplex, you must contact your physician to obtain the proper medication to prevent such outbreaks for at least 4 days before and after the procedure (follow your physician's instructions).

Micropigmentation is a process. Two or three sessions may be required to achieve the desired results. It is not uncommon to lose up to 70% of the colour after the first session.

**Please Note** that having a procedure done while on your menstrual cycle can make you hypersensitive to the procedure.

Meant to Last will provide detailed after-care instructions at the time of any of the above procedures. It will be in your best interest to use and apply as instructed by the artist.
